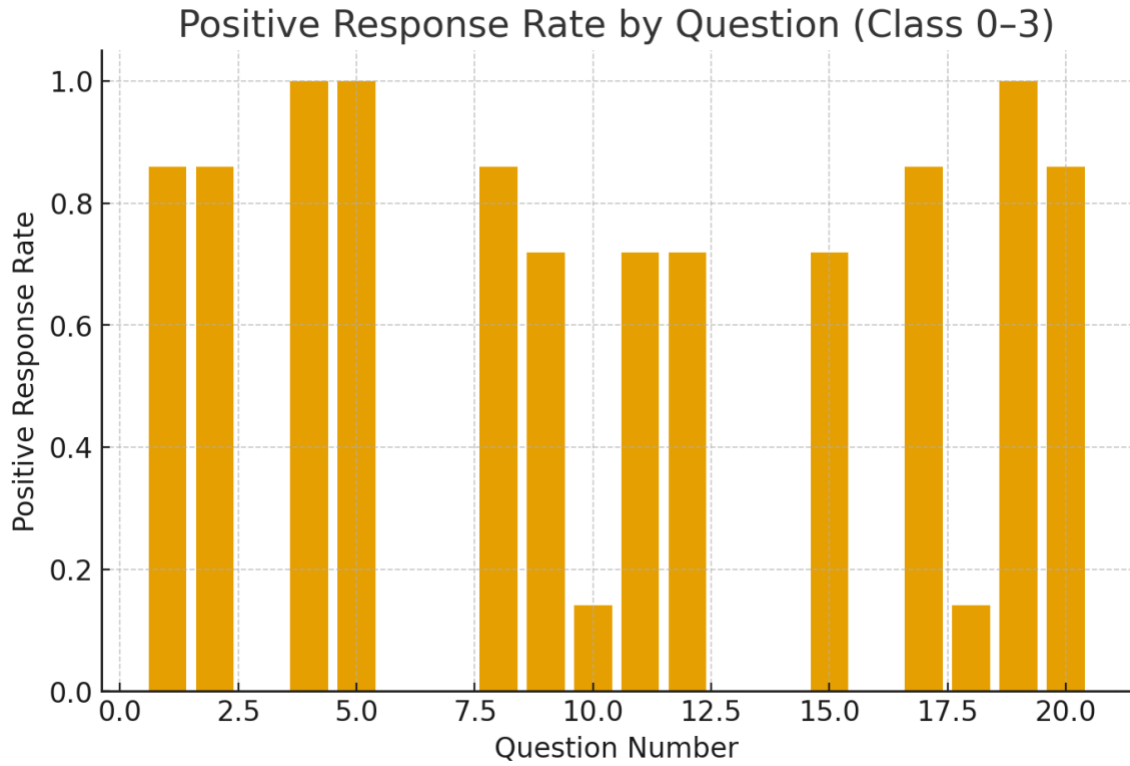


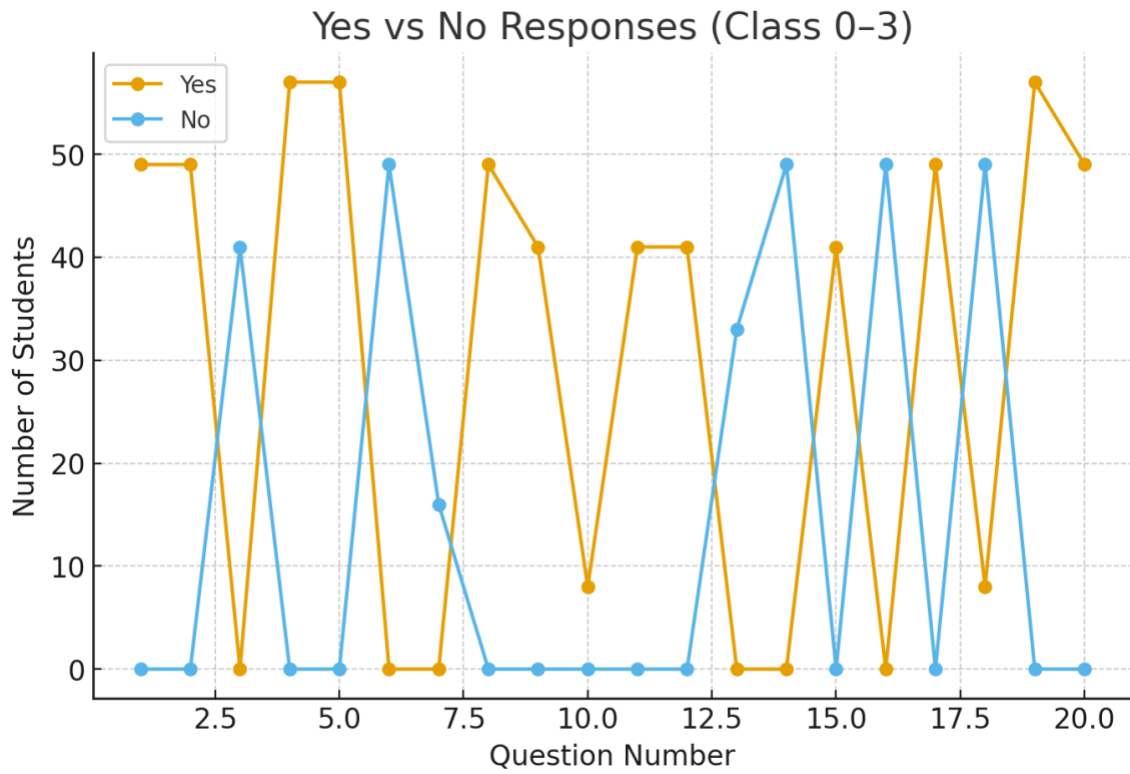
Environmental Report Class 0–3

Summary Graph

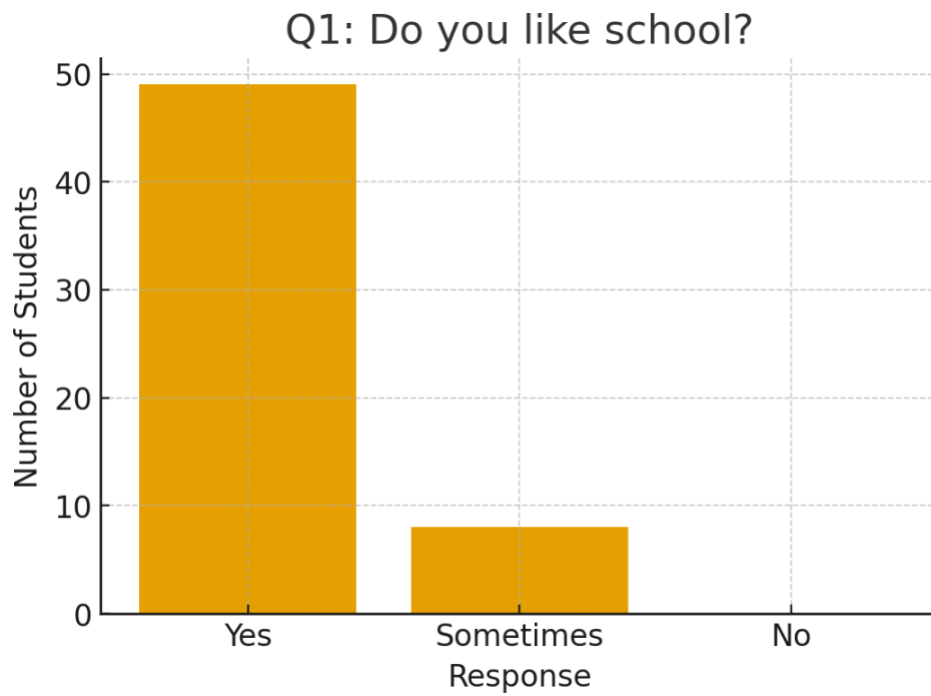


Yes vs No Comparison

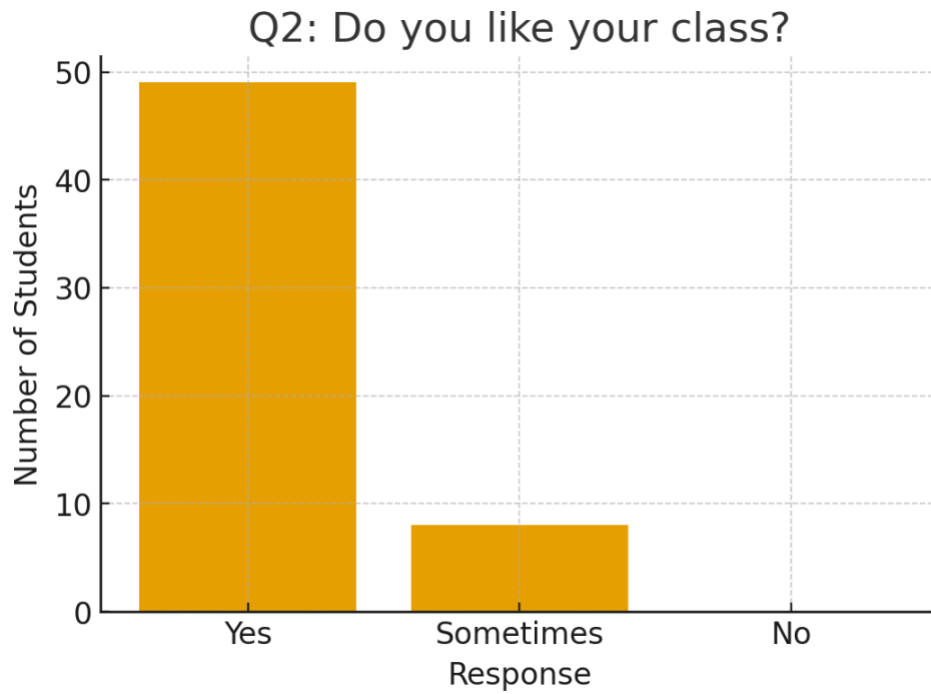

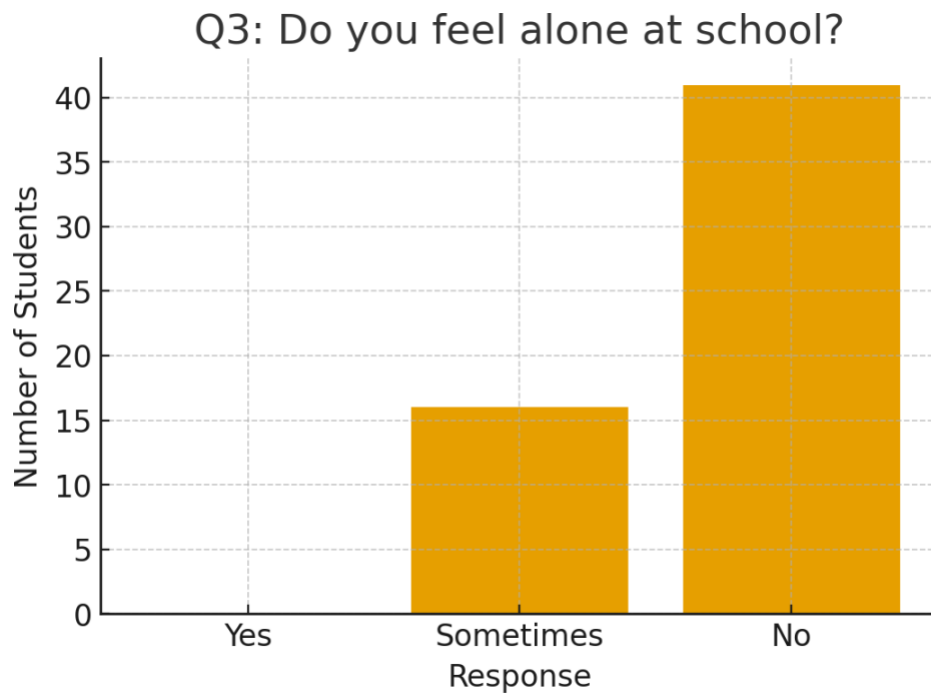

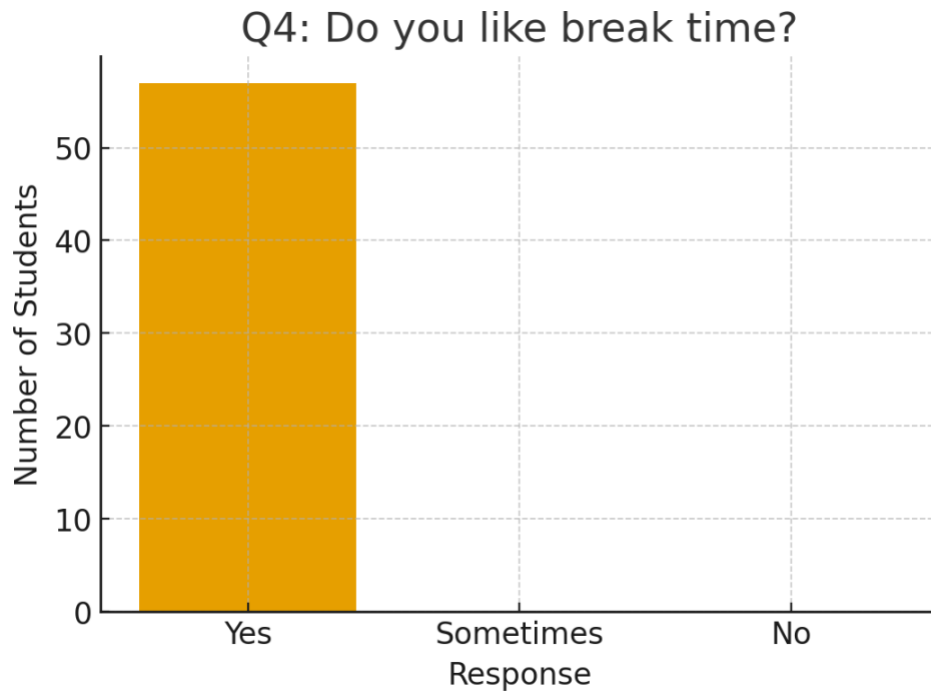
Question 2: Do you like your class?



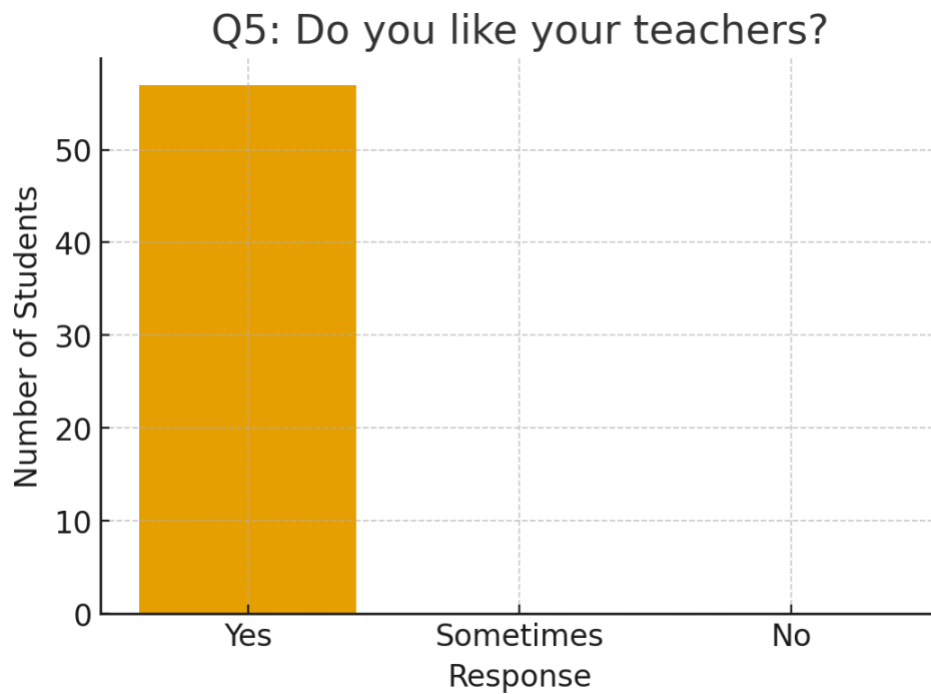
Question 3: Do you feel alone at school?



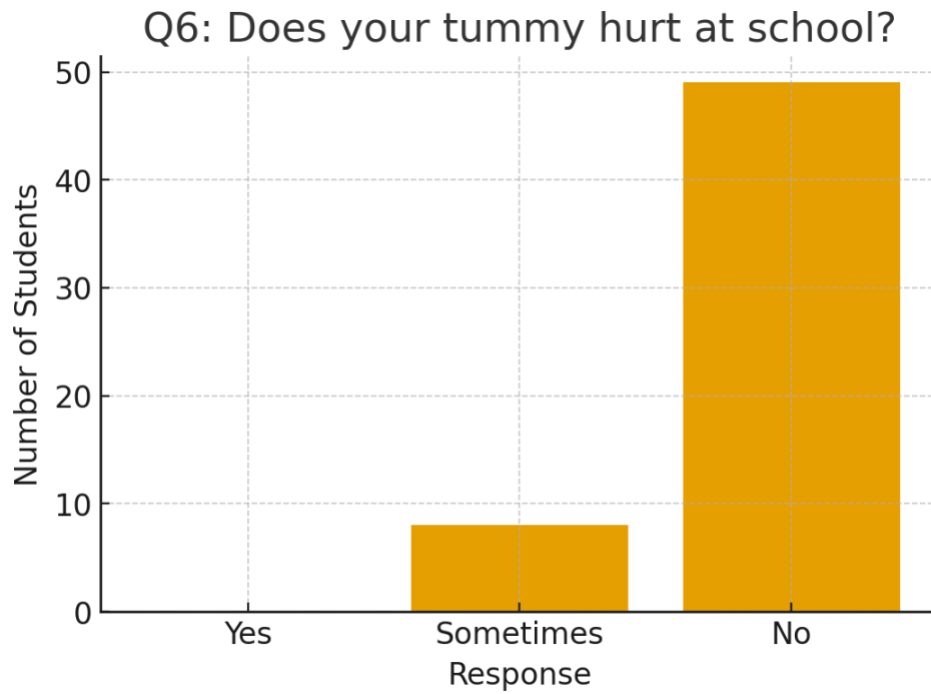

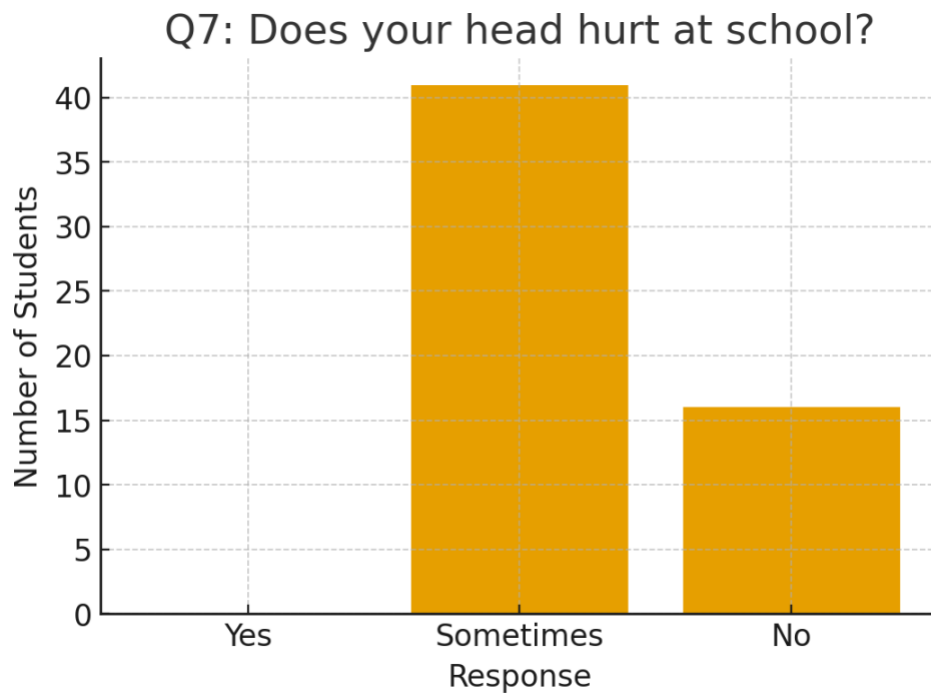

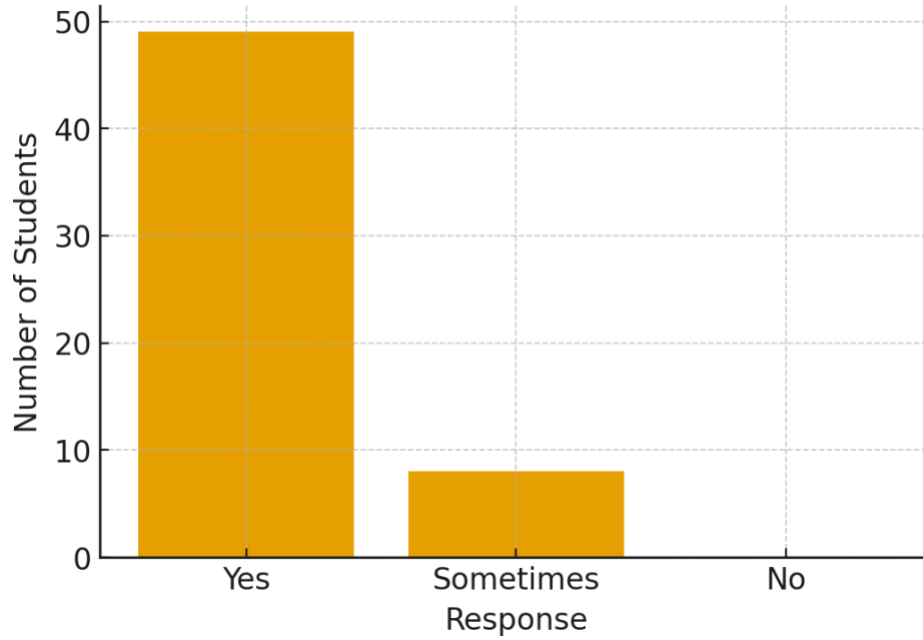

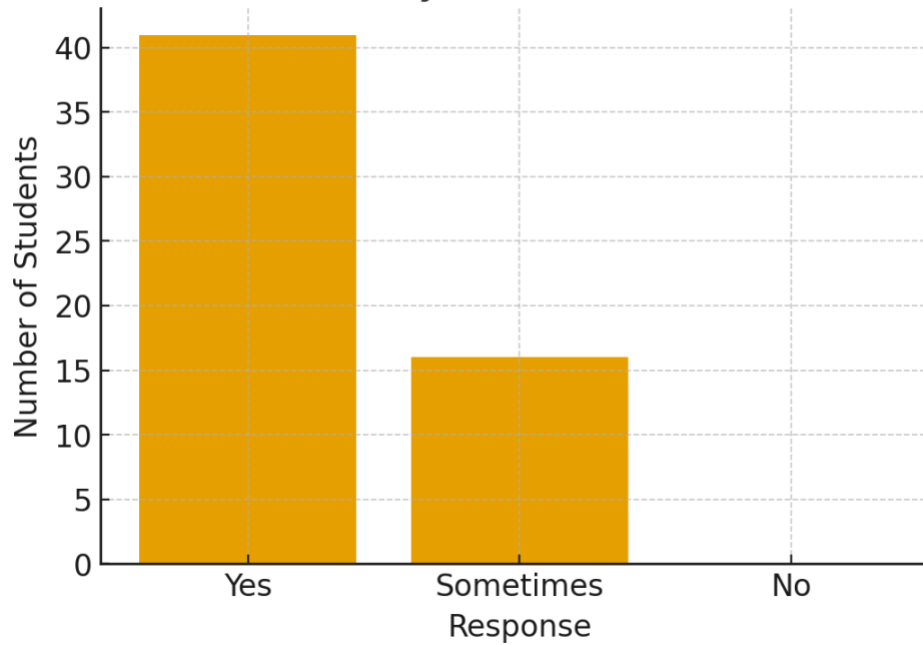

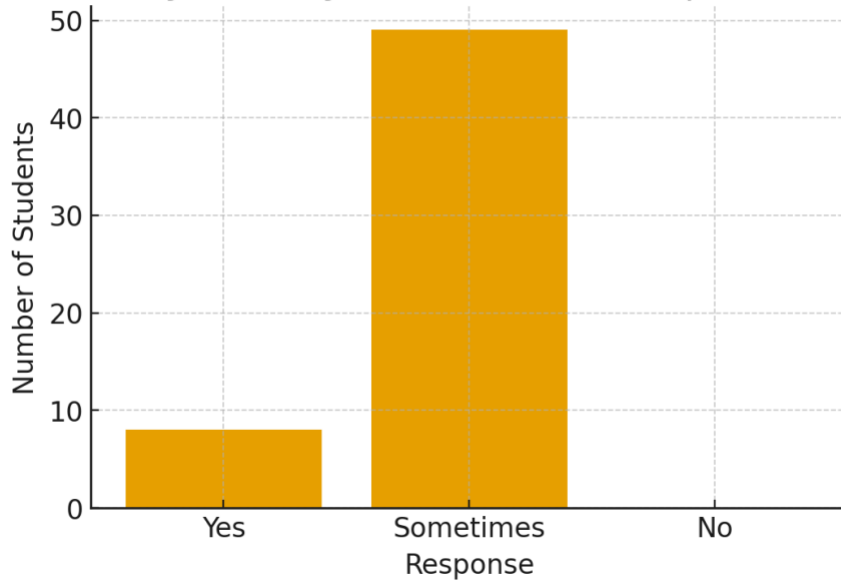

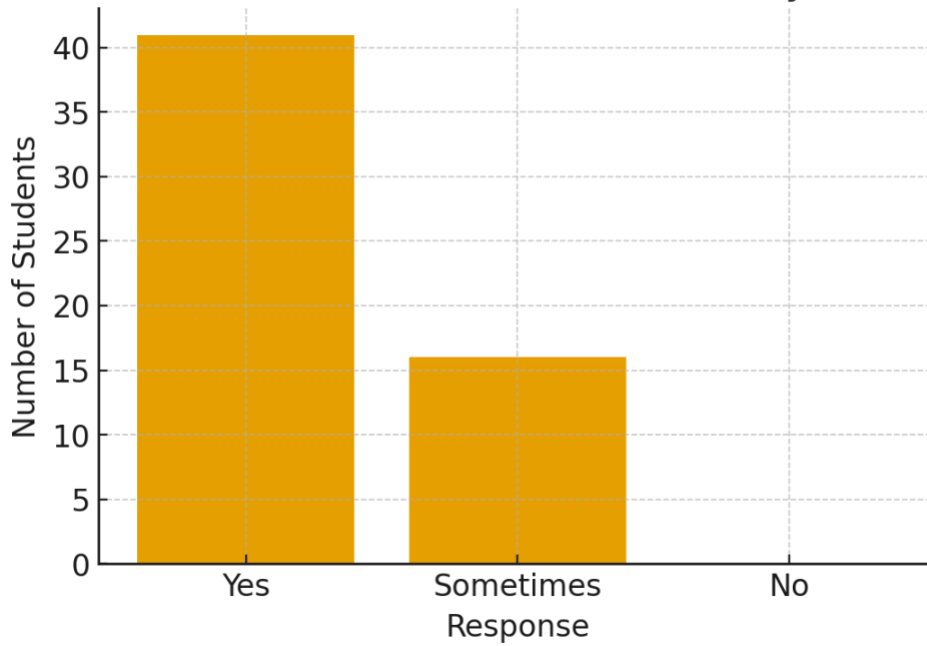

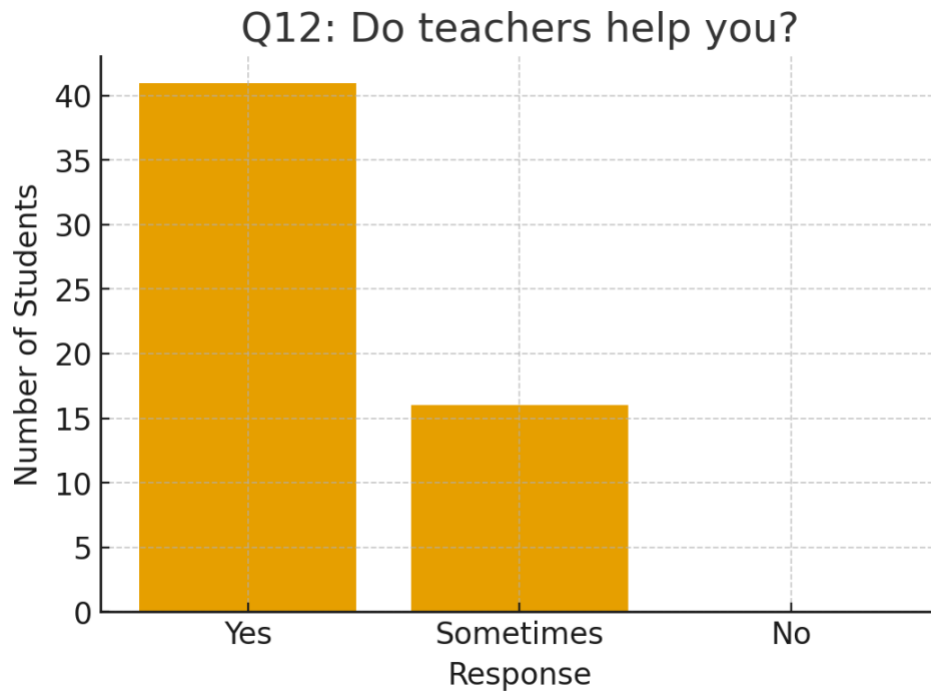

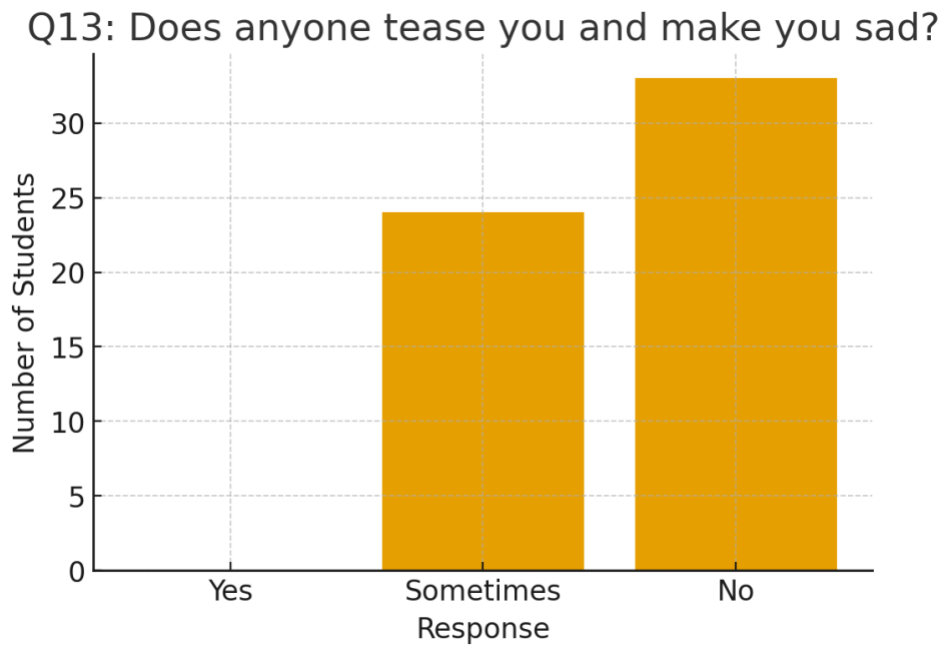

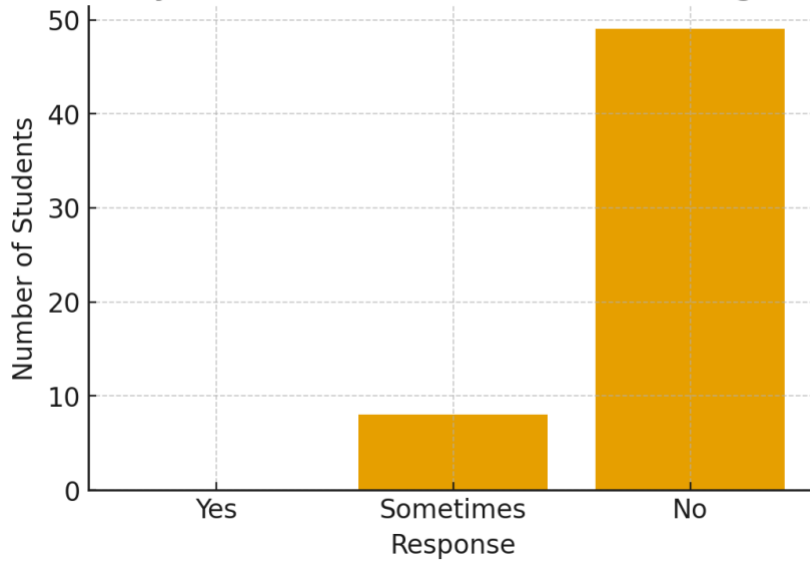

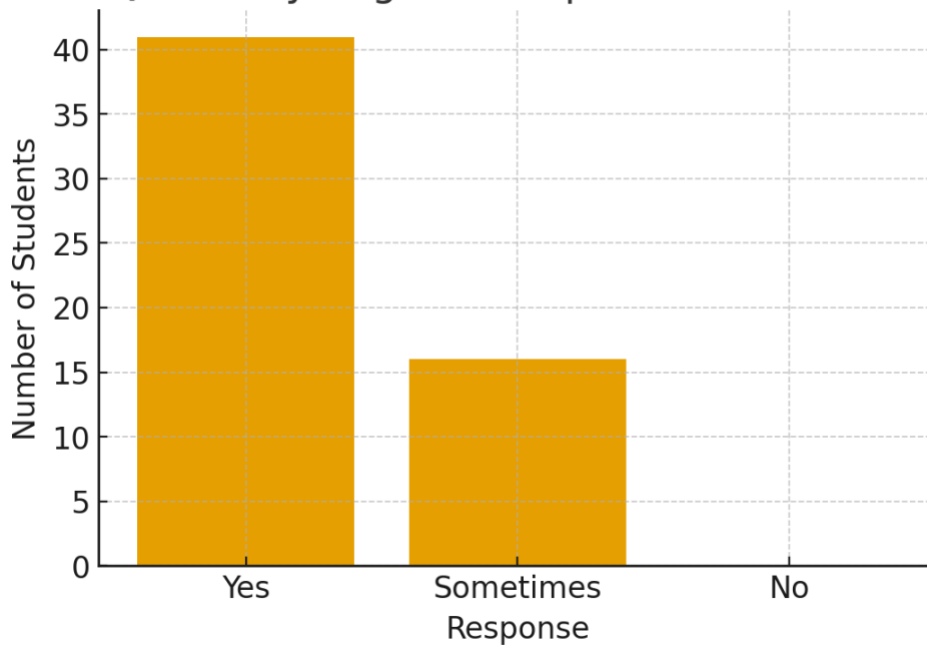

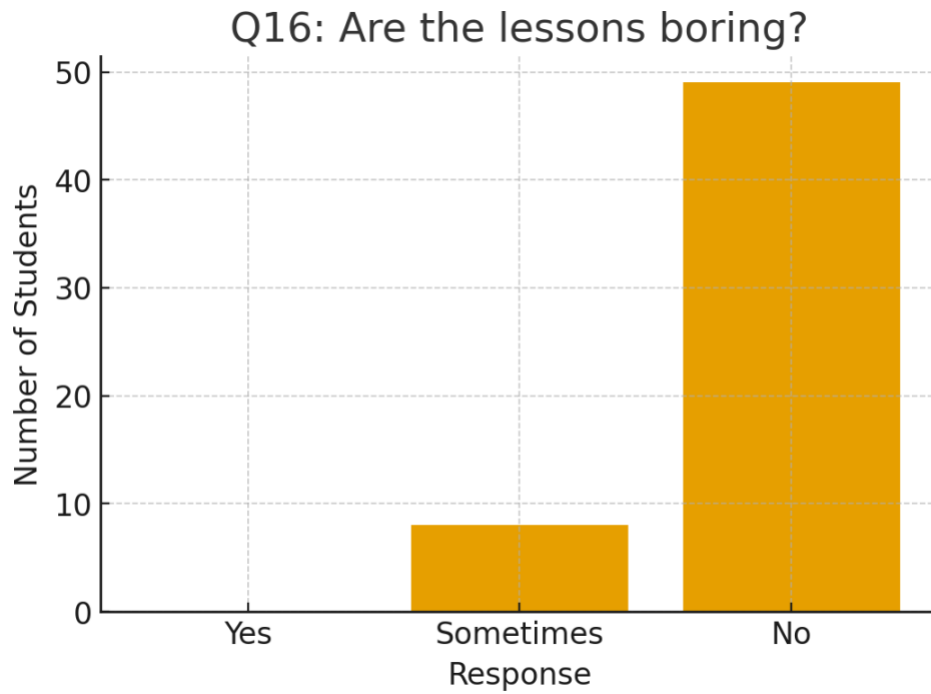

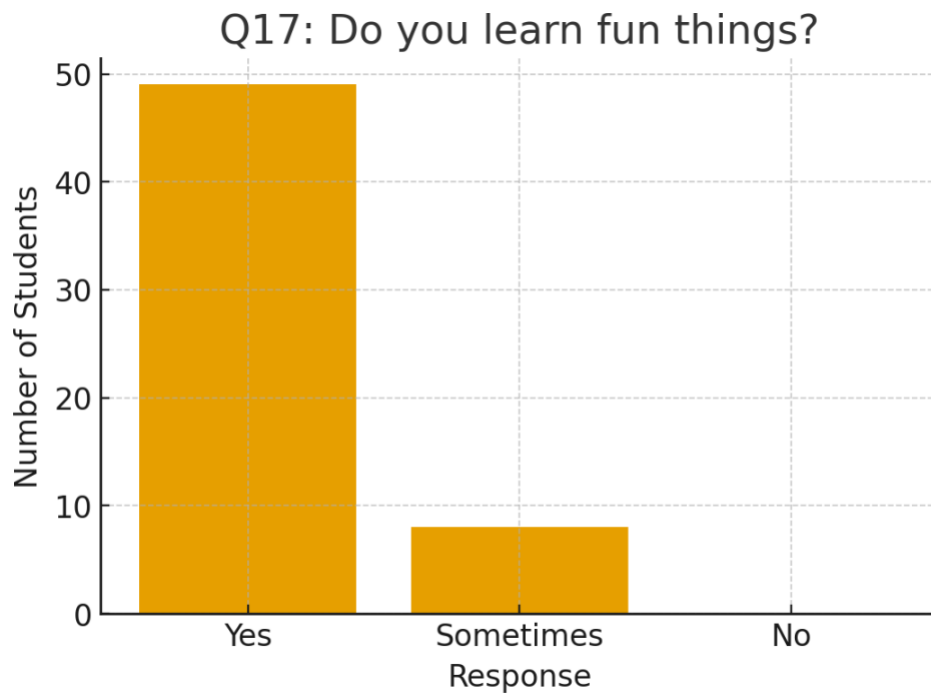

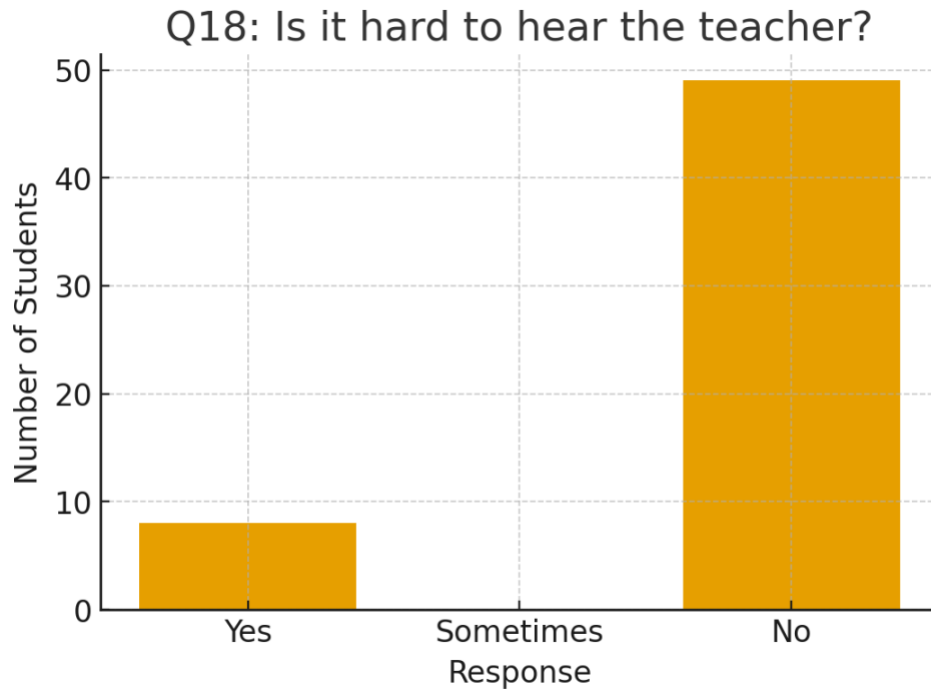

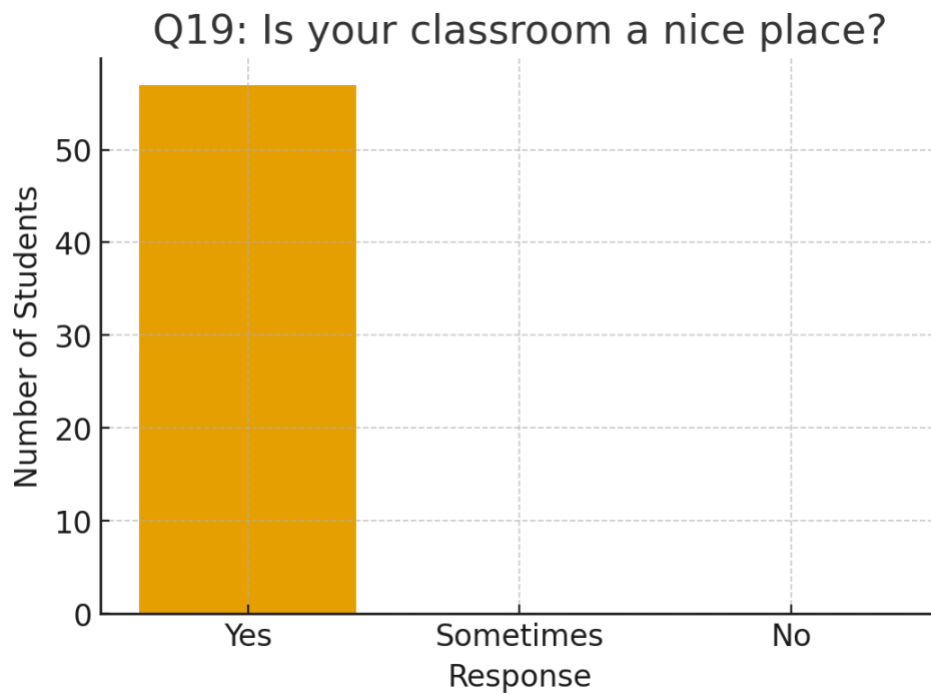

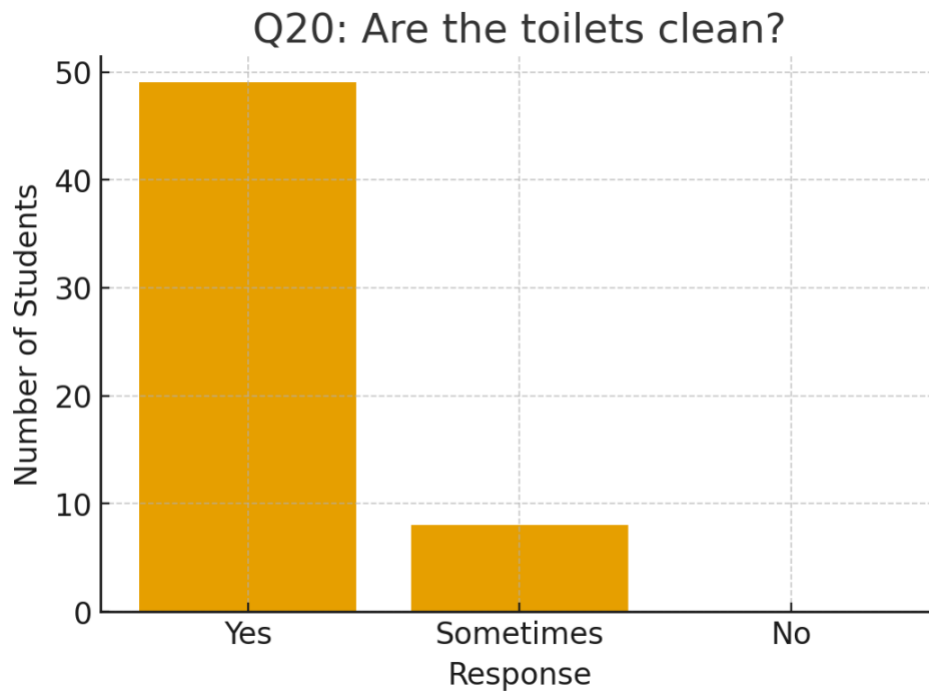

Conclusion

The Class 0–3 results show strong overall wellbeing. Children enjoy school, feel supported by teachers, and report positive peer relationships. Only a minority experience discomfort, fear of teasing, or challenges.

Strengths

- Very high levels of happiness and enjoyment at school.
- Strong sense of classroom belonging and supportive relationships.
- Confidence in problem-solving and learning new things.
- Highly positive perception of the physical environment.

Areas for Improvement

- Some children experience teasing or fear of being laughed at.
- Stomachaches, headaches, or discomfort appear for a subset of students.
- Emotional wellbeing routines and peer-support systems should continue to be a priority.
